Code of Conduct

Purpose

The New Covenant Community Development Center (NCCDC) STEM Learning Center is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and positive learning environment for all students, parents, and staff. The following Code of Conduct outlines our expectations to ensure that all participants can grow, learn, and succeed together.

1. Respectful Behavior

- All students, parents, and guardians are expected to treat staff, volunteers, and other students with kindness and respect at all times.
- Bullying, teasing, physical aggression, disrespectful language, or disruptive behavior will <u>NOT</u> <u>BE TOLERATED</u> under any circumstances.
- Parents are expected to model positive and respectful behavior during all interactions with staff and other families.

2. No Tolerance Policy

NCCDC STEM Learning Center maintains a **ZERO-TOLERANCE POLICY** for:

- Physical fighting or threats
- Inappropriate or abusive language
- Disrespect toward staff or peers
- Damage or theft of property
- Repeated noncompliance with staff instructions

Any violation of this policy may result in immediate dismissal from the program for the student and/or restrictions placed on parent participation.

3. Attendance and Punctuality

- Students are expected to arrive on time and attend all scheduled sessions unless excused in advance.
- Parents must ensure students are picked up promptly at the designated dismissal time.

4. Late Pickup Policy

To respect staff time and ensure student safety, the NCCDC STEM Learning Center enforces a **late pickup fee**. Pickup starts at 5:30 pm; you are considered late after 6:01 pm.

- A fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged for each minute a parent or guardian is late picking up their child.
- Payment is due in cash at the time of pickup on the same day.

 Example: If you are 10 minutes late, the late fee will be \$10.00, payable upon pickup.
- Repeated late pickups may result in dismissal from the program.

5. Property and Materials

- Students should respect all NCCDC property, equipment, and materials.
- Any intentional damage may result in disciplinary action and reimbursement for repair or replacement.

7. Parent Cooperation

- Parents are expected to communicate promptly with staff regarding absences, emergencies, or behavior concerns.
- Parents must support the Learning Center's policies and work collaboratively with staff to promote student success.

8. Disciplinary Actions

Violations of this Code of Conduct may result in:

- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Parent conference
- 3. Dismissal from the program
